The ADAMI Media Prize 2018 Deadline Is Over

Yesterday was the final deadline for submissions to the ADAMI Media Prize 2018 competition. We are thrilled to announce that we have received more than 300 submissions from our six EU Eastern Partnership countries! The ADMI team is now finalizing preparations for the International jury session, to be held in Odessa, Ukraine, 22-26 October. Twenty-four media professionals, senior diplomats, journalists and film directors from around Europe will gather to review all applications and determine the nominees and winners of this year's ADAMI scholarships and prizes. All of those nominated will be invited to attend the ADAMI Media Prize Gala ceremony in Chisinau, Moldova on 29 November.

Whatever the outcome, all works submitted for the ADAMI Media Prize receive significant international exposure; every submission is reviewed by a jury of international media experts and is published for global viewing in the ADAMI Digital Media Archive.
